ACONITE

Aconite is a plant from the Ranunculaceae family. Some words Sankaran uses to give us the sensation of this family are 'vexed, easily excited, raw nerves, electric shock, anger with grief, shock and annoyed, bursting'. He places it in the acute miasm and suggests their feeling could be 'acutely and suddenly vexed'. It is associated with the base chakra.



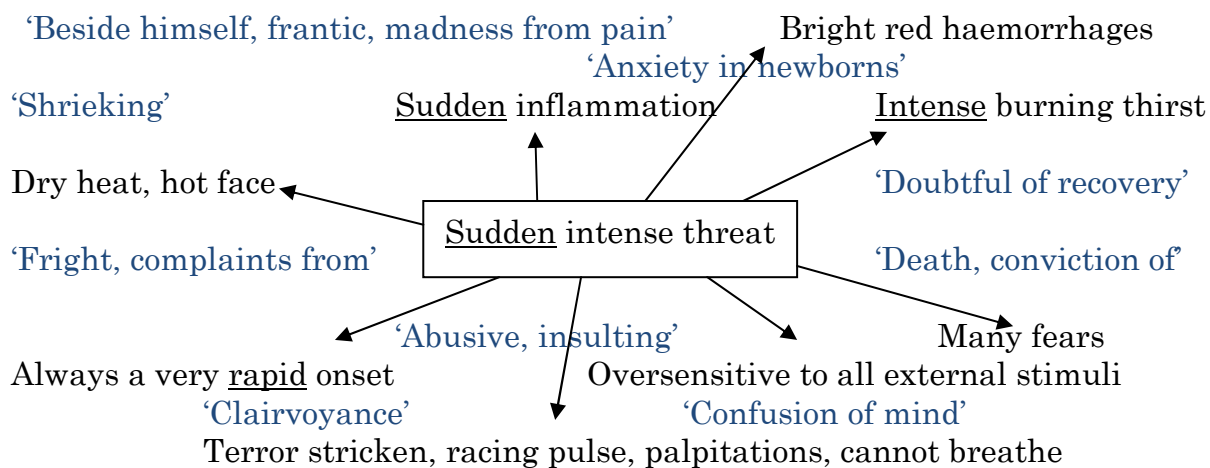
Aconite i

Modalities: Chilly, Thirsty

Worse: NIGHT, FRIGHT, SHOCK, GETTING COLD, *violent emotions, dry wind, dentition, vexation.*

Better: Open air, rest, warm perspiration.

Affinities: MIND, NERVES, HEART, *brain, abdominal organs, joints, right side, left side.*



This remedy has a very fast action. Symptoms are acute, violent and painful.

The four elements: Excitability v fear of death, predicting the moment of death, night time aggravation, dry burning heat.

Therapeutics:

Ailments that develop very suddenly

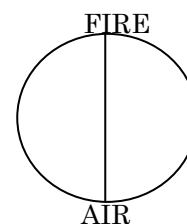
Effects of fright

Conjunctivitis, especially at the beginning

Croup, especially in a child who had a rapid birth

Retention of urine caused by shock, especially in newborns

Jaundice in new babies



Some Mind SRP'S:

Affection, has none during pregnancy

Rage, fury, alternating with laughing

Anxiety before apathy

Delirium, with jerking

Anxiety in chest, extending to head

Impatience, throws himself about

Anguish with spasms of pain

Dreams of waking

Fear of death with loquacity

Fear of death in pregnancy

Fear, to go out of bed
